(a) No person may remove a tree larger than three (3) inches in diameter, measured at a point four and one-half (4½) feet above the ground within the urban county government right-of-way without obtaining a permit from the urban forester or his designated arborist. (b) The permit shall be granted provided the tree to be removed is dead or dying. (c) The urban forester or his designee may issue permits for the removal of live trees only in special circumstances. Instances where a permit for the removal of a live tree may be issued include, but are not limited to, the following: (1) The tree is a threat to the public safety; (2) The tree is a threat to the health of other trees in the community; or (3) The tree is to be replaced by a more desirable tree. (d) If the urban forester or his designated arborist determines that a street tree is a hazardous tree, he can order the property owner to remove the hazardous tree in a timely manner, as determined by the urban forester or his designated arborist at the property		I agree to comply with the city's Street Tree Ordinance (Chapter 17B-3) regarding tree removal.
